Seminole State has grown from a single-campus community college into a dynamic state educational institution with four campuses and Seminole Online, 200 degrees and programs including seven bachelor's degrees, and 30,000 students annually. Seminole State has awarded more than 100,000 credentials in its 53-year history.

According to the State Board of Education, nearly 96 percent of Seminole State's graduates are employed or continuing their education, and the average starting wage for the College's graduates is more than double the average starting wage in Seminole County.

Case in point, the School of Business, Health and Public Safety provides educational pathways to high-demand and high-wage careers that enable individuals to be financially self-sufficient. These programs strengthen the region's economic health and prepare individuals for

lifelong, rewarding careers. Central Florida's major employers participate as advisory board members, helping to design curricula so that graduates can integrate technical skills, critical thinking and leadership. Each of the programs readies graduates for immediate employment in their career field and provides the option to continue their education to a bachelor's degree.
