Florida Hospital will soon be AdventHealth.

**S**eminole County is home to two Florida Hospital locations, Florida Hospital Altamonte and Florida Hospital Lake Mary ER.

Florida Hospital is a member of Adventist Health System, which operates 50 hospitals in nearly a dozen states, making it the largest not-for-profit healthcare system in the United States.

For 2018–2019, U.S. News and World Report recognized Florida Hospital as one of Florida’s best hospitals in 16 types of care. In addition, multiple Florida Hospital campuses were awarded an “A” Safety Grade by the Leap Frog Group. This year Florida Hospital announced the addition of a second free-standing emergency department coming to Oviedo in 2019.

Florida Hospital Altamonte, a 398-bed acute-care hospital in Altamonte Springs, was established in 1973 as Florida Hospital’s first satellite campus, and it continues to be a leading healthcare provider in Seminole County.

Florida Hospital Altamonte offers a

full suite of services and departments, including:

- An emergency department
- The Heartburn and Reflux Center, a unique medical and surgical partnership that works to diagnose and treat GERD, based on individual needs
- The Spine Health Institute, led by internationally renowned spine surgeon Dr. Chetan Patel
- Women’s health services, including a Breast Imaging Center of Excellence recognized by the American College of Radiology
- The Cancer Institute, the only facility in Seminole County utilizing TrueBeam technology, delivering more precise and effective radiation for cancer treatments
- A Multidisciplinary Breast Cancer Clinic that provides world-class evaluation and care for patients with diagnosed breast malignancies, bringing together physicians from multiple specialties to provide the full range of medical and surgical therapies in a one-stop location for breast cancer care

- Minimally invasive and robotic surgery: Florida Hospital Altamonte is the first hospital in Seminole County to utilize robotic technology—the da Vinci® Si Surgical System
- Cardiovascular care with three catheterization labs and interventional radiology
- The Baby Place at Altamonte strongly supports a personalized birth experience with specialized training and equipment for natural labor and includes the only Level II NICU in Seminole County, allowing its tiniest and most vulnerable patients to get care closer to home.

Florida Hospital Lake Mary ER continues to provide the same high level of critical care found in other emergency departments. This stand-alone facility offers convenient access to:

- Board-certified emergency physicians, critical care nurses, stroke specialists and heart attack experts
- A full-service ER with 24 beds
- Rapid assessment zones to expedite care for your emergencies
- Helicopter and ambulance transport
- Onsite imaging and lab services.

# CENTRAL FLORIDA

## Regional Hospital, Sanford, Florida

Central Florida Regional Hospital, a 221-bed acute-care hospital and Level II Trauma Center, serves residents of Seminole County, west Volusia County and beyond. The Level II Trauma Center provides life-saving care to critically injured patients from a five-county area, including victims of motor vehicle accidents, falls and penetrating wounds.

The only full-service cardiovascular program in Seminole and west Volusia counties, Central Florida Regional Hospital offers open-heart surgery, interventional cardiology, electrophysiology, cardiac rehabilitation and comprehensive diagnostic services. Central Florida Regional Hospital is an Accredited Chest Pain Center with PCI from the American College of Cardiology and Joint Commission Certified Advanced Primary Stroke Center.

Central Florida Regional Hospital's surgical services include general surgery, orthopedics, neurosurgery, cardiac and thoracic surgery, plastic surgery, ENT, obstetrics and gynecology, podiatry, urology and vascular surgery. Minimally invasive treatment alternatives are available



for many patients, including robotic surgery for gynecology, general surgery, thoracic surgery and urology.

Central Florida Regional Hospital also offers advanced technology for early detection and treatment of lung cancer, leading to better outcomes through minimally invasive treatment. In addition, Central Florida Regional Hospital vascular services provide the most current treatment options for a wide range of vascular and endovascular diagnoses, including carotid artery disease, peripheral arterial disease and abdominal aortic aneurysms.

The Rehabilitation Center at Central Florida Regional Hospital provides acute inpatient medical rehabilitation for patients with complex conditions such as stroke, spinal cord injury, amputations or brain injury. The Rehabilitation Center helps patients minimize physical or cognitive disabilities and gain greater independence after illness, injury or surgery. It has 13 large private rooms, a physical therapy gym, independent living suites and 24-hour immediate access to all hospital services. The

Rehabilitation Center earned the highest level of accreditation awarded by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities.

In addition to emergency services provided at its main campus in Sanford, Central Florida Regional Hospital ER at International Parkway is scheduled to open in early 2019. The freestanding emergency department will provide 24/7 emergency care to northwest Seminole County and surrounding areas. The new ER will feature 12 private patient care rooms, a dedicated trauma room, laboratory services and diagnostic imaging, including CT scan, ultrasound and x-ray.

## South Seminole Hospital, Longwood

**S**outh Seminole Hospital is part of Orlando Health, a \$3.4 billion not-for-profit healthcare system with eight wholly-owned or affiliated hospitals, an extensive physician practice network, and multiple care centers throughout Central Florida. The 206-bed acute care hospital was founded in 1984 and is located on State Road 434 in Longwood. South Seminole Hospital serves more than 45,000 patients each year through both its inpatient and outpatient facilities, and the 36-bed emergency department sees more than 30,000 patients annually.

In November 2017, South Seminole Hospital opened its new, expanded outpatient rehabilitation clinic, which provides enhanced treatment options and greater patient comfort. This new facility, located next to the hospital, offers sports medicine therapies that serve everyone from professional players to weekend athletes. In addition, patients will benefit from a full range of rehabilitation services that include physical therapy for improved mobility, occupational therapy for improved activities of daily life, and speech language pathology for speech impairments and cognitive memory issues. The clinic features all-new, state-of-the-art treatment equipment, like the AlterG® Anti-Gravity Tread-

mill that provides unweighted therapy to patients recovering from injuries, surgeries, or balance or neurological disorders.

South Seminole Hospital is also home to Orlando Health Behavioral Health, an 80-bed inpatient facility for patients needing comprehensive care for mental health issues. The hospital also serves as one of Orlando Health's three air care team helicopter bases, allowing for direct transport of critically ill or injured patients to the region's only level one trauma center at Orlando Health's Orlando Regional Medical Center, where patients can receive the highest level of emergency care available.

Other services at South Seminole Hospital include the following:

- 24-hour emergency care, with a dedicated area for minor emergencies
- Advanced diagnostics
- Cancer services (located in Lake Mary)
- Endoscopy
- Laboratory and pathology
- Orthopedics and sports medicine
- Outpatient care, including same-day surgery
- Pulmonary critical care
- Radiology and diagnostic imaging
- Rehabilitation and physical medicine
- Spiritual care
- Urology

- Women's imaging center with digital mammography
- Women's services
- Wound care and hyperbaric medicine

Orlando Health is currently building a freestanding emergency room and medical pavilion on the corner of Manderley Run and Rinehart Road in Lake Mary. The new ER will include up to 24 patient beds, a lab, an imaging department, ambulance bays, and a helipad, while the medical office building will have 60,000 square feet of space for a variety of healthcare services, such as an ambulatory surgical center, outpatient imaging and lab services, and a retail pharmacy. Long-term plans for the site include an acute-care hospital and additional medical office space. The new healthcare campus will open in fall 2019.

Orlando Health is one of Central Florida's largest employers, with more than 20,000 employees and 2,900 affiliated physicians, and is the institutional sponsor of seven residency and 19 fellowship programs. With more than 112,000 inpatient admissions and nearly 2.4 million outpatient visits each year, Orlando Health provides healthcare access to nearly three million Central Florida residents. Annually, nearly 10,000 international patients receive care at Orlando Health as well. Additionally, Orlando Health provides more than \$450 million in total value to the community in the form of charity care, community benefit programs, and services each year.
